



July 4, operation commences, Battalions from Sindh Regt. (SR) And Northern Light Infantry (NLI) with Frontier Corps (FC) and artillery support move south-east into Ali Sherzai tribal area

Mid-July, lashkars begin operating against militants in Masuzai tribal area

Manatu, Taliban HQ, site of heaviest resistance; Manatu and Murghan taken by July 6

SR and NLI battalions link up at Mandana by July 13

Main advances made by July 6; 42 FF establishes overwatch on Sper Kot ridgeline

July 4, operation commences, 42 Frontier Force (FF) and 42 Punjab Regt. (PR) battalions with FC and artillery support move north and west. 42 FF moves to Dumbakai, 42 PR moves to Tanna
